We have moved!

With construction work completed, the Oklahoma City Community Foundation staff moved into the new building in early July.

During July and August as minor detail work on the interior was completed, landscaping crews worked around the unseasonable rains to install nearly 500 trees and shrubs around the perimeter of the building. With such a high profile location at 10th and Broadway, landscaping is an important element to the new building and adds a significant touch of green to midtown Oklahoma City. Visitors to the building will find a wide variety of permanent plantings including bald cypress trees, crepe myrtle shrubs, roses, magnolia trees, boxwood hedges, monkey grass, Shantung maple trees, Nellie Stevens hollies and shore junipers. The landscaping project required 225 bags of compost, 295 bags of mulch and 5,400 feet of sod.

The completion of the building signals an exciting new chapter in the history of the Oklahoma City Community Foundation. First discussed in 2004 at a Trustee retreat, this project came to fruition thanks to the leadership and dedication of many.

We are looking forward to showing off the new building and are planning a number of events throughout the fall including a community open house on Thursday, October 11th.
