

Sculpture Honoring John Belt Installed in Paseo District

Following the 2013 death of John Belt, our longtime general counsel, the Oklahoma City Community Foundation partnered with the Paseo Arts Association and asked artists to submit a proposal to create a sculpture in his honor. Through a competitive process, artist Jonathan W. Hils was selected and awarded \$30,000 to create his vision, Flamenco. Mr. Hils is an arts professor at the University of Oklahoma. The sculpture was permanently installed on April 23, 2015 in the median at the intersection of Paseo Drive and Northwest 29th Street in the Paseo Arts District. John was a passionate advocate for the arts and helped to transform the Paseo Arts District into a thriving haven for artists.
