Oklahoma City Community Foundation

The Oklahoma City Community Foundation is a nonprofit organization established in 1969 to receive and administer funds for assisting in the advancement of medicine, education, the arts, social services and civic organizations in the Oklahoma City area.

The Foundation does this by encouraging contributions, carefully managing donor gifts and conscientiously distributing funds for charitable purposes which will benefit the citizens of the community. An indication of the Foundation's success is the growing list of citizens and corporations which have made contributions to the Foundation, bringing total assets from \$45,299 in 1969 to more than \$21 million at the end of 1983.

The Foundation has established several types of funding methods from which donors can choose for management and distribution of their contributions. While detailed information on these various funding methods is available through the offices of the Foundation, generally speaking they fall into two broad categories:

Undesignated Funds — The use of income and principal from these contributions (which can be made in any amount) is left entirely to the judgement of the Board of Trustees. This is the favored funding method of the Foundation, as the Trustees — selected for their competent knowledge of the community and its philanthropic needs — can respond each year in light of current charitable needs. All contributions of less than \$500 must be undesignated. The law requires that at least one-half of the Foundation's assets be in undesignated funds.

Designated Funds — Donors may designate qualified, tax-exempt charitable entities to receive grants from the income or principal of these funds, so long as the Board of Trustees deems the charities appropriate to community needs. Contributions of \$5,000 or more may create a new individual fund; contributions of \$500 or more may be made to any existing fund.



The Board of Trustees

The Board of Trustees is the Foundation's governing body and also serves as the Distribution Committee. The Committee authorizes and controls all grants made from funds of the Foundation in accordance with the terms governing each fund. The nine members of the Board meet quarterly and serve for three-year staggered terms for a maximum of ten years. Each trustee was chosen for the position because of his or her integrity, leadership and understanding of the philanthropic needs of the Oklahoma City community.

The Fiscal Committee

The Fiscal Committee is independent of the Board of Trustees and is made up of representatives of five community banks, which have been designated as Fiscal Trustees of the Foundation. The Fiscal Committee works to assist in managing the Foundation's investments, but each bank's trust department remains responsible for donor funds placed in its care. The annual earnings of each trust fund are passed on to the Board of Trustees for distribution of grants.

The Oklahoma City Community Foundation has experienced remarkable growth during the past three years. Assets have grown from \$8,233,592 at year end 1980 to \$21, 290,407 at the end of fiscal 1983. This represents a 159 percent or \$13,056,845 increase in total assets.

Contributions for the past three years totalled \$12,162,639. Of this amount special attention is called to the matched credit donations of John and Eleanor Kirkpatrick totalling \$839,525, which includes \$367,754 contributed during 1983, that resulted in additional contributions of \$1,679,050. The concern these two remarkable individuals have for the community of Oklahoma City underlies their inaugural donation which created the Foundation in 1969. Their program of matched credit donations is witness not only to their considerable generosity, but also to their continuing interest in their community. The Foundation's Trustees, along with the donors and philanthropic entities which derive benefits from the Kirkpatricks' gifts, are deeply appreciative of their considerable benevolence and their continuing efforts to better the quality of life for the Oklahoma City community.

Special acknowledgement is given to particular "in kind" contributions which the Foundation's Annual Report does not record. One of these contributions is the Annual Distribution Dinner, which is funded entirely by one Trustee. Another "in kind" contribution is provided by a Trustee who bears most of the expense for the Foundation's Annual Report. Additionally, the Trustees, in an effort to insure maximum efficiency and advantage in the management of invested funds, now have the advice and counsel of SEI (formerly A. G. Becker), whose charges are defrayed by another Trustee. Grateful appreciation is expressed for these Trustee donations, which are provided in the spirit of the precedents set by the Kirkpatricks.

On behalf of the Foundation Trustees and the Oklahoma City community, sincere appreciation is expressed to Mr. Jack H. Abernathy who retired last September after 10 years of service as a Foundation Trustee. His generosity with his resources is reflected in the Foundation's Annual Report. His contributions as a working board member were immeasurable.

The Foundation's Trustees feel an ever present challenge of stewardship and an obligation to assure the Foundation's financial health. Following the wishes of the individual donors to provide philanthropic stability for the community of Oklahoma City is the foremost goal of the Trustees.

Notes To Financial Statements Oklahoma City Community Foundation, Inc.

December 31, 1983

The Oklahoma City Community Foundation, Inc., was incorporated December 30, 1968 under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, as a non-profit organization without capital stock for charitable and educational purposes pertaining to the community of greater Oklahoma City.

Note A - Significant Accounting Policies

Donations: Certain donations made to the Foundation have been designated for a particular purpose by the donors. It is the expressed intention of the Foundation to honor the designations of donors; however, the Foundation reserves the power to exercise final control over all funds.

Investments: Securities and other investments are maintained by five trustee banks in various trust funds and are carried at the lower of cost or amounts determined by estates at the time of bequest or market. Costs of donated assets are estimated fair market value at date of gift.

Property and Equipment: Furniture and fixtures are stated on the basis of cost. Depreciation is computed on the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of the assets. Investments in producing oil and gas properties are amortized based on production and are not of accumulated depletion of \$269.940 for December 31, 1983 and \$148,931 for January 31, 1983.

Reclassification: Certain amounts in the January 51, 1983 financial statements have been reclassified to be comparable to the December 31, 1983 amounts.

The foundation owns 100% of the stock of a corporation which, at January 31, 1983, was in the process of being liquidated. At that date, the value included above was \$700,000, which was based on the fair market value of the corporation's underlying assets. During 1983 the Corporation's plan of liquidation was rescinded. Because the fair market value of the corporation's underlying assets at December 31, 1983 is not readily obtainable, it has been shown at the Foundation's carrying value. The investment is being accounted for on the equity method. The carrying value is increased by the income earned by the corporation and decreased by the distributions received.

Note C - Income Taxes

The Internal Revenue Service has ruled that the Foundation qualifies under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is, therefore, not subject to tax under present income tax laws.
