1. After October 1, visit occf.academicworks.com to determine if you are eligible for a scholarship.
2. Click **Sign Up** to create a student account.
3. Complete the **General Application** and submit the required documents.
4. After submitting the General Application, click on **View Opportunities** to review the scholarships recommended for you.
5. Follow the prompts to apply for each recommended scholarship. Answer the additional questions required for each scholarship.

Online applications open October 1.

Scholarship deadlines vary, with most closing January-March.
