## Student eligibility requirements:

- Oklahoma high school graduate or GED recipient.
- Age 25 or younger at time of application.
- In the Oklahoma Department of Human Services' foster care system, or aged out, at the time of graduation from high school or at the time of obtaining a GED.
- Plans to enroll as a full-time student at an academically-accredited nonprofit institution in Oklahoma including colleges, universities or technology centers.
- Maintains a collegiate GPA greater than or equal to 2.0 to be eligible to reapply.
