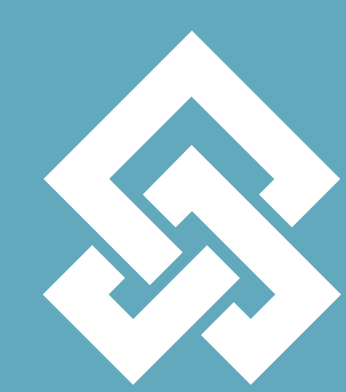
Scholarship recipient Dominic Knight with Amber Williams
