



A brief overview of the emergency response grants we awarded in 2020 that were made possible by Oklahoma City Community Foundation donors.



2020 DISASTER RELIEF FUND

A total of **\$529,250** was distributed to 17 organizations in central Oklahoma, including the following seven grants that specifically focus on health care and senior citizen support:

- Central Oklahoma Health Impact Team | **\$150,000** to provide initial funding for a shelter for individuals experiencing homelessness who have COVID-19 symptoms, or those who need to be isolated from other shelter residents.
- Community Health Centers of Oklahoma | **\$16,500** to provide PPE for staff and patients and medication for individuals experiencing homelessness.
- Dentists for the Disabled and Elderly | **\$5,000** for emergency extractions.
- Health Alliance for the Uninsured | **\$51,500** to support increased staffing, supplies and prescription medications for their partnering low-cost clinics.
- HeartLine | **\$25,000** to fund a chatbot to help with increased call volume about COVID-related questions.
- Skyline Urban Ministry | **\$25,000** to provide food and community support for senior citizens.
- Sunbeam Family Services | **\$35,000** to support senior citizens experiencing homelessness.



OKLAHOMA DISASTER RELIEF FOR ANIMAL SUPPORT

A total of **\$119,766** was distributed to 17 Oklahoma charitable organizations continuing to make an impact for animals throughout the COVID-19 pandemic.

**Gifts to this fund were specifically directed to animal support.*



DONOR-ESTABLISHED EMERGENCY RESPONSE GRANTS

Ninety-one grants totaling **\$786,680** were distributed through donor-established funds at the Oklahoma City Community Foundation to help with emergency response in 2020.
